My site runs in a sub directory example: subdomain.mydomain.com.au The site is www.mydomain.com.au The goal is to have all my traffic go to the www version of the website. I want to be able to make a redirect: If you are on subdomain.mydomain.com.au to www.mydomain.com.au I have tried the following in my.htaccess file: RewriteEngine On RewriteBase / RewriteRule ^((www)?(.\*)) [L,R=301] This works, but I get the "The requested URL /(mydomain)/(www) was not found on this server." issue. I have also tried this: RewriteEngine On RewriteBase / RewriteCond %{HTTP\_HOST}!^www.mydomain.com.au [NC] RewriteRule ^((www)?(.\*)) [L,R=301] This gives me the error "Cannot redirect to (Not Found)". After much Googling and testing I have come to the conclusion that the www. should not be in the RewriteCond. If I put it in the rule, it doesn't work. If I remove it, I get the Not Found error. Any help would be greatly appreciated! Cheers
