What should one do when doing the following: (A) starts a question with an attempt to solve a problem by doing a Google search (B) adds results to the question, e.g. an external link or a brief description of a search result (C) visits a question and comments something along the lines of "I don't do this, but here are some links where you could look for help" All three possibilities should be good to ask, but not necessarily answerable. Although (C) does not really fit the definition of a list, it does constitute a not constructive list in a lot of cases. The response to this "listing" activity should not be an attempt to "close" the question, but something more like: "Okay, I've given you a list, please read it and update the question with the results". Note that the question about the applicability of the community rules on custom close reasons is valid, but has a different objective. A: What should one do when doing the following? (A) starts a question with an attempt to solve a problem by doing a Google search (B) adds results to the question, e.g. an external link or a brief description of a search result (C) visits a question and comments something along the lines of "I don't do this, but here are some links where you could look for help" There is simply no reason why such questions should be around. The only thing we should do in such cases is to remove them - delete. A question might be a duplicate and the user might not be able to decide what they need to know from different questions. But when there is a glaringly obvious problem with the question, then we should remove it rather than having it hanging around here like a bad smell. When other people find such questions, they should close them as "Unable to locate answer" or perhaps as "Too broad"
